Our Mission

The Sons of Norway Foundation is dedicated to funding activities that preserve and promote Norwegian heritage, positively affect members, and make Sons of Norway communities a more vibrant place to live.

Overview

Established in 2005, the Helen Tronvold Norwegian Folk High School Scholarship supports the Sons of Norway Foundation's objective of providing cross-cultural experiences for youth. Helen Tronvold remembered Sons of Norway youth with a special bequest in her will that is a major source of funding for this scholarship. Sons of Norway members also donate to the fund to help it grow.

Eligibility

- Applicants who are current members of Sons of Norway or children or grandchildren of current members.*
- Applicants who are between the ages of 17-26.
- Those who have a certificate of completion from a US high school.
- Scholarships may only be used to pay for tuition only for upcoming studies between June 2018-May 2019. The Foundation does not provide financial assistance for current or previous academic years, room/board, travel, etc.

Criteria

- A short autobiography, 150 words or less.
- An essay of 500 words or less addressing each of the following key points:
 - Describe how this scholarship will help you further your cross-cultural career goals.
 - State how your course of study will benefit your community and be in accord with at least one of the following the goals and objectives of the Sons of Norway Foundation: (1) promoting improved international relationships, (2) providing people-to-people enrichment programs, (3) promoting culture exchange or (4) promoting humanitarian causes.
 - Describe your involvement in the Sons of Norway and how it has shaped who you are today.
 - Explain how you will share this experience with the Sons of Norway or wider audiences.
- Academic potential: Upload a copy of your most recent transcripts.
Please note, "official" transcripts may be required once an applicant is tentatively selected.
- Financial need: Be prepared to include the amount you are able to pay for post-secondary education/training in the online application.
- Two letters of recommendation that address the applicant's character and abilities.

Application Process

Applications are only accepted via our online portal at www.sonsofnorway.com/scholarships. The steps to apply are as follows:

- 1) Go into the scholarship portal at www.sonsofnorway.com/scholarships and create a username and password.
Please note: The username and password will be different from your Sons of Norway membership login. You must create new credentials every year you apply for a scholarship.
- 2) Complete the profile section that includes your contact information.
- 3) Select the scholarship(s) for which you would like to apply and complete those application(s).
Please note: As of the 2017 scholarship year, applicants will be limited to applying for either domestic scholarships OR international scholarships, not both. However, you may apply for as many scholarships in either category for which you are eligible.
- 4) Upload all required supplementary attachments to the portal including: a copy of your transcripts, your letters of recommendation and a high resolution photograph (for use in the Viking magazine, etc. should you receive an award).
Please note: ONLY send letters of recommendation via e-mail to scholarship@sofn.com should the author(s) of the letter(s) require they remain confidential. If a reference e-mails a letter on your behalf be sure they include your name and the name of the scholarship in the subject line.
- 5) Check the box stating that you, the applicant, have completed the application and that no one else
- 6) Send your final submission no later than January 15.

Award Selection

Final selection of the scholarship winners will be made by a scholarship committee appointed by the Sons of Norway Foundation. Scoring is dependent on the use of complete sentences, proper grammar, and inclusion of information outlined in the essay requirements listed above.

Candidates may only receive two Sons of Norway scholarships in a five-year period.

Award Amount

One scholarship recipient will be selected for an award of up to \$3,000.

Scholarship Notification and Payment

Notification of an award will be made by phone within 14 weeks of the application deadline.

Students attending folk high schools typically pay their tuition in full and then request reimbursement from the Sons of Norway Foundation. In this instance we simply need a copy of your tuition receipt. The alternative option is for the Sons of Norway Foundation to send payment directly to the folk high school for your account. Please be sure to include your student ID number on the application and the contact information for your folk high school of choice to assure timely payment.

Recipient Requirements

Scholarship recipients are expected to grant permission to use their photo and name in the Viking magazine, the Foundation's annual report and other scholarship promotional materials. They are also expected to give a presentation, including photos, at their Sons of Norway lodge or one close to them to explain how this scholarship is helping them achieve their educational dreams. We will provide you with a form for a lodge officer to sign after your presentation.

* Membership must be in effect at least one calendar year prior to application. Students may only apply under their parents' or grandparents' Sons of Norway membership if they are age 26 or younger.
