Sons of Norway Foundation experienced a banner year of fundraising, providing assistance to our members, lodges and their communities. Here's a look at the numbers.

**\$640,000**  
in contributions was raised in 2016.

**\$28,000**  
in 62 grant awards to projects supporting youth, heritage and culture.

**\$77,000**  
in scholarships were awarded to 24 exceptional students.

### Lund Fund Scholarship

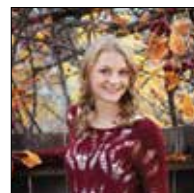
