Offered to Sons of Norway lodges that wish to promote Norwegian heritage through programming in their communities.

## **General Heritage & Culture Grants**

Offered to individuals, groups or organizations that promote Norwegian heritage and culture to wider audiences.

## **Sons of Norway Foundation Humanitarian Fund**

Founded in response to the Red River Floods of 1997 and continues today, offering two kinds of grants:

### **Helping Hands to Members Grants**

Awarded to Sons of Norway members affected by natural disasters such as tornadoes, floods, wildfires, earthquakes and hurricanes.

In 2013 Sons of Norway families impacted by flooding in Colorado and Calgary were awarded these grants.

### **Helping Hands to Children Grants**

Awarded to support Norwegian heritage programming, for children in lodges, schools and for Project Framtid.

# Where are they now?

Scholarships from the Sons of Norway Foundation provide students with the chance to pursue their academic dreams. We caught up with some past recipients who are making a difference in the world.



## **A) Dr. Jill Bente Rolland -**

### **King Olav V Norwegian-American Scholarship**

In 1992 I received my scholarship from Sons of Norway which supported a trip to Austervoll, Norway to do a summer internship at the Austervoll marine biological station. That summer internship was pivotal in my career and led me to pursue graduate studies at the University of Bergen. In the fall of 2012 I became the director of the U.S. Dept. of the Interior, U.S. Geological Survey's Western Fisheries Research Center in Seattle, WA. My time in Norway resulted in many collaborations with Norwegian scientists at the University of Bergen and the Norwegian Veterinary Institute that are ongoing today.

## **B) Rachel Peterson -**

### **King Olav V Norwegian-American Scholarship**

In 2006 I was fortunate to receive a scholarship from Sons of Norway to help me complete my master's degree in Peace & Conflict Transformation Studies at the University of Tromsø, Norway. During the 2006-2007 academic year, I visited the Nobel Museum in Karlskoga and proudly posed for a picture with a statue of Alfred Nobel. Little did I know that seven years later I would be working as Program Manager for the Nobel Peace Prize Forum in Minneapolis. I am happy to be back in Minnesota and am thrilled to be working for the Nobel Peace Prize Forum.

## **C) Christine (Bjerkhoel) Kramer -**

### **Astrid G. Cates Scholarship**

I'm profoundly grateful for the scholarship from Sons of Norway that enabled me to pursue my B.S. in Electrical Engineering from the University of California-Davis where I graduated with Highest Honors in 2001. Following graduation I have worked for Agilent Technologies and Qualcomm Technologies, Inc. where I develop and test automation tools for wireless devices used all over the world.

## **D) Alissa Bjerkhoel -**

### **Astrid G. Cates Scholarship**

I am heavily indebted to Sons of Norway for their contribution to my education through the scholarship I was awarded. With the assistance of Sons of Norway I pursued my B.A. from the University of California-Santa Barbara and later pursued my J.D. from California Western School of Law. After I obtained my J.D. I started working as Supervising Attorney for the California Innocence Project, a law firm that investigates claims of wrongful conviction. I have received several awards including the 2012 California Lawyer of the Year award. None of this would have been possible without the support I received from Sons of Norway.
