One Successful Social Honor Your President

Purpose

To honor all past presidents.

To update newer members about the past accomplishments and activities of the lodge.

Needed

Social director or another lodge member willing to organize and prepare the program.

All past presidents should be asked to attend.

Historical records, newsletters and minutes from lodge meetings should be researched to pick out the highlights of the lodge during each president's term of office.

Past presidents in attendance are called forward and seated while the activities of the lodge are read for their term of office.

After the records of the lodge are read, each past president is asked if he/she has any remarks to add about his/her term of office.

For the older lodges this will be inconvenient, but they might concentrate on the past 20 or 25 years and summarize the activities and honor the presidents of those years—or any other chosen period of time.

If there are presidents from prior years, or other periods of time in attendance, their accomplishments might be included in the program.
