The church is built from logs harvested in 1851-1852. The first service was held on May 27, 1852 and the last service was held in 1887.

Howard Kiezke is a historian and sexton for the Hauge Log Church and Cemetery. Richard Fredrickson is President of the 1852 Hauge Log Church Preservation Association.
