



Peter Herman's Landscape Photography focused on images from Stoughton-area and Norwegian-settled areas of North Dakota

Peter Herman was born and raised on a farm in North Dakota. He first became interested in photography during high-school, and after acquiring a Pentax SLR, began taking photos for the school yearbook and developing/printing B&W images in school darkroom. He continued shooting through college, taking portraits, group pictures, weddings, but after beginning his engineering career at Cummins, he let his photography interests go semi-dormant until about 2005 when he acquired his first DSLR and once again started shooting scenic landscapes from around the US, but concentrating especially on rural areas in ND and WI.

Peter will share his journey as a photographer and discuss "tools of the trade", along with a few words on his photo post-processing/editing philosophy. He will display and discuss photographs selected from his portfolio focused on four general categories. They include images shot in and around Stoughton, photos from areas of North Dakota where Norwegians heavily settled (direct immigrants from Norway plus many from WI, MN, etc.) especially highlighting some the historical abandoned farm homesteads and Norwegian Lutheran churches that dot the rural landscape, "abstract/impressionist" work, and a few examples of photography in the infrared spectrum.
