All of these great programs exist through the generosity of all our Foundation donors and friends.



Each camp experience is unique, but every one of them provides Norwegian culture and heritage activities, in addition to the opportunity for campers to make new friends and learn more about life in Norway.

The Foundation loves to hear from campers of decades gone by about how their camperships made an impact on their lives. We were thrilled to receive this testimonial from Kiaja Klabo, past Skogfjorden villager of years ago who now gets to continue the Skogfjorden camp tradition with her own daughter.

***“Sons of Norway was incredibly impactful upon my childhood and into adulthood. Being part of the Oslo Lodge 1-002 Junior Lodge laid the foundation for my love of Norway, the Norwegian culture and ultimately learning to speak Norwegian. I have many fond memories of learning and performing Norwegian folk dances but also of the many cultural activities we were exposed to through Sons of Norway. It was Sons of Norway Foundation that supported my attendance at multiple camps, expanding my love of Norway. The Foundation enabled me to attend Skogfjorden Norwegian Language Village for multiple summers, where my basic knowledge of the Norwegian language began to flourish. The Foundation also helped me to attend Camp Norway the summer after my freshman year of college. This was foundational to enabling me to minor in Norwegian at Concordia College in Moorhead, Minnesota. Now, I am able to begin to pass this love down to the next generation, as my daughter will attend Skogfjorden\* for the first time this summer.” – Kiaja Klabo***

Today Kiaja is a Senior Director in the marketing and promotion field in Minnesota. She has been a teacher of Norwegian language in a community education setting, is a proud Concordia College alumna and was even a Sons of Norway intern one summer!

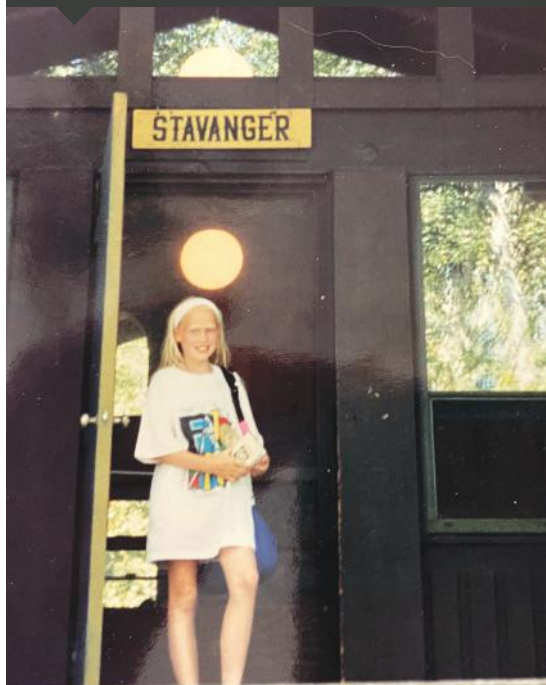

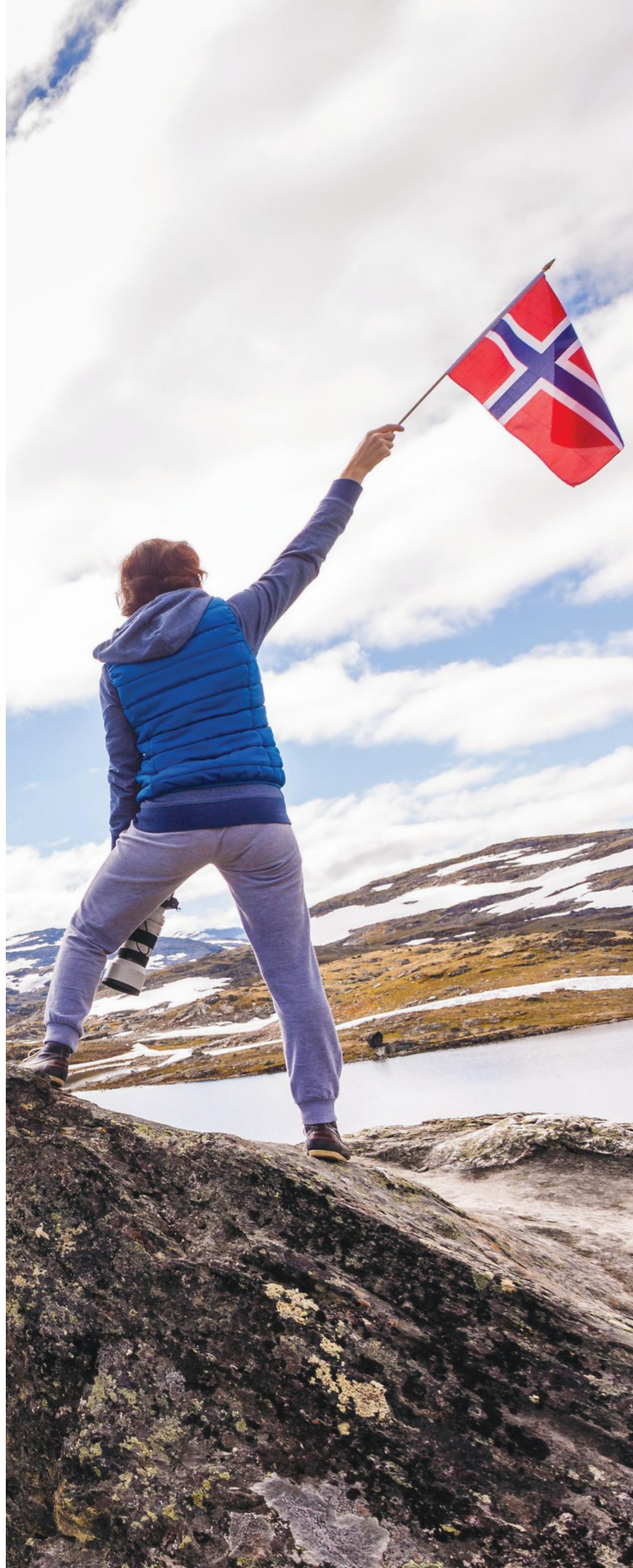
